


Because trap selectivity is an important part of modern trapping, we recommend the use of breakaway snares.

The S-Hook is a device added to snares components to allow ungulates accidentally caught by the foot to break away. However, it does not decrease snare performance for target species. By changing the snare closing angle, the S-Hook even offers greater flexibility and increases the sliding action of the lock on the cable, ensuring faster and more efficient closing.

Two models of S-Hook are provided depending on the species occurring in your area:





How S-Hook works

Model	To Capture	To Release
Senneker Elite 385	Coyote, Fox, Canada lynx, Bobcat	White-tailed deer, Caribou, Moose
Senneker Elite 750	Wolf, Coyote, Fox, Canada lynx, Bobcat	Moose

These S-Hook can be used with "mechanical" locks (e.g. Camlock) and several other models.

Building steps:



Insert the large loop of the S-Hook into the lock hole.
Close the loops completely without flattening them.



Insert the cable into the small loop.



Pass the cable through the lock.
